Best of Breed Competition classes may be divided at the discretion of the judge. Information will be posted at the ring entrance in advance of the judging.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- **The grooming areas will be available to exhibitors at 10:00 AM Tuesday, May 6 (or when ready). Dogs must be removed from the show site 1 hour following completion of Best of Breed judging on Saturday, May 10.
- **There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.
- **All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience, rally or agility rings.
- **All crating must be within designated areas. No exercise pens will be allowed inside the building.
- **Parents shall be responsible for their children.
- **The show-giving clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
- **The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of, an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows.
- **Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.
- **No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, unless specifically allowed for in AKC Rules & Regulations.
- **Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

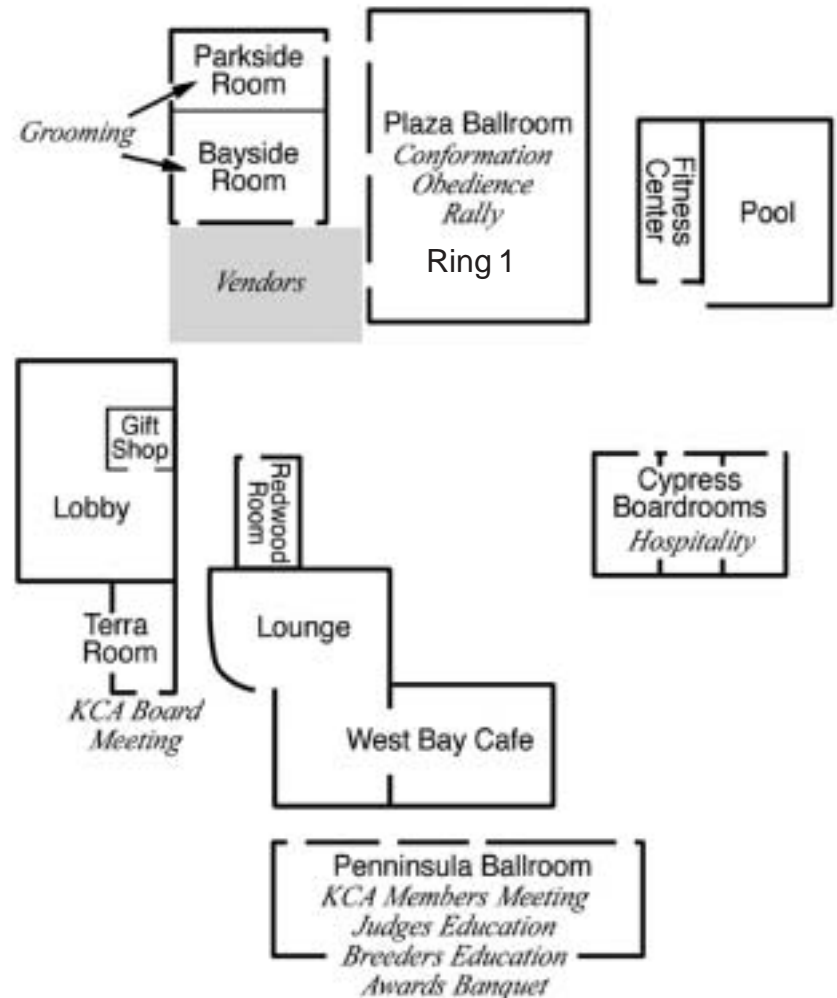
